It is a great partnership and Dr. Fisher helped make that happen. He also volunteers with Mission of Mercy Dental outreach that holds large scale mobile dental clinics around the state of Nebraska. Also recognized at the ceremony and receiving the Youth Award was Mikayla Savell-Flott, a freshman at Creighton University for her volunteer efforts and service to the Omaha community.
